The group said we should do



We used lots of your ideas to make this plan.


## 4 big things that can be better

You said there are 4 big things we need to work on most.

### 1. The way people think about people with disability



You said the way people think about people with disability is a big issue.



You said there needs to be more ways to see all the things that people with disability are doing in Byron Shire.



You said people with disability should have a say on how information about them is shared.



You said people with disability will be more included if it is easy for them to use places in the community.



We will share the good things we are doing with people with disability.



This will help the community see how it is done.



We will train our staff to make including people with disability the most important thing they work on.



We will make sure the community understand and follow the disability parking rules.

### 2. Making Byron Shire an easy place to live



Byron Shire should be a place that is easy to live in.



You said we need to make public transport

- Better
- · Easier to use.



You said that it should be easier to get to and use our beaches.



You also said there should be

- · Better footpaths
- More parking
- More toilets for people with disability to use.



We will work together with the community to make places easier to get to.



This could be places like

- Health care centres
- Banks
- Places people go on holiday.



We will make public transport better and have more bus shelters.



We will make it easier to get to Council buildings.

- Parking
- Toilets.



We will make sure everyone can use our beaches.



We will have more events that everyone can go to.



We will make sure that everyone can use our

- Parks
- Playgrounds
- Places where people meet up.

## 3. More jobs



You told us that more people with disability should have jobs in Byron Shire.



You said it needs to be easier for people with disability to go for jobs.



Workplaces need to do better when they support people with disability.



Workplaces could do things like let people work hours that are good for them.



There needs to be more good jobs for young people with disability.



We will tell businesses why it is good to have more jobs for people with disability.



We will do training about working with people with disability

- At Council
- In the community.



We will make it better for people to

- Use the buildings that they work in
- Get to workplace training.

### 4. Better information



You told us that we need to get better at

- The ways we talk to people with disability
- How we give information.



We need to let people know about Council services and events in ways that different people can use.



This could be

- · Face to face
- Online.



People with disability need to be included when we make community plans.



We will give information in a way everyone can understand.

We will make sure our staff know how to support people in the community to follow the Council rules.

We will choose Council staff to be in charge of different parts of the plan.



They will report on how things are going 1 time every month.



We will show the community how things are going 4 times a year.



In the Annual Report we will say what we have done to reach the goals of the plan.


