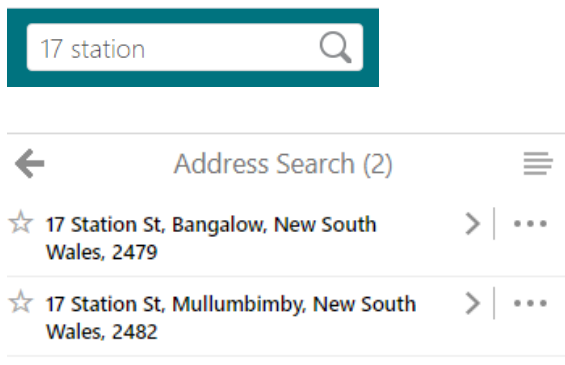

How to find a property

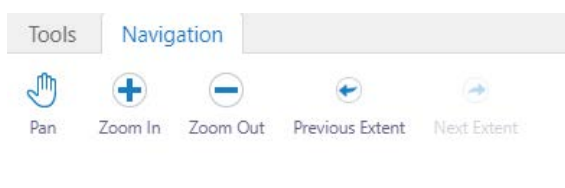
Use the Search box to search for an address. Click on the search result in the side panel to zoom to that location.



OR use the pan and zoom tools, or two fingers on a touch screen, to navigate.

How to navigate around the map

Use the navigation toolbar to pan and zoom around the map.

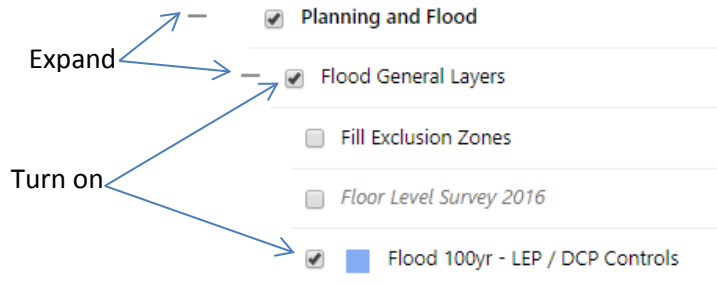


How to view layers

Click the Layers tab at the bottom of the panel.

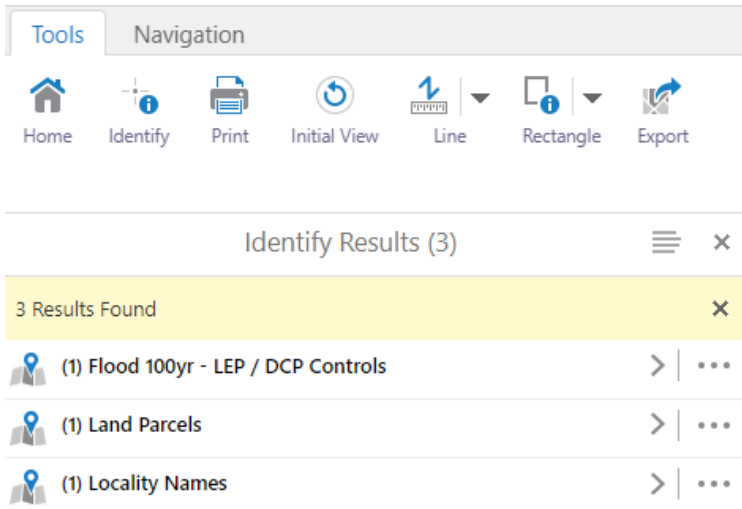


Expand your layers of interest, and click the boxes to turn the layers on.



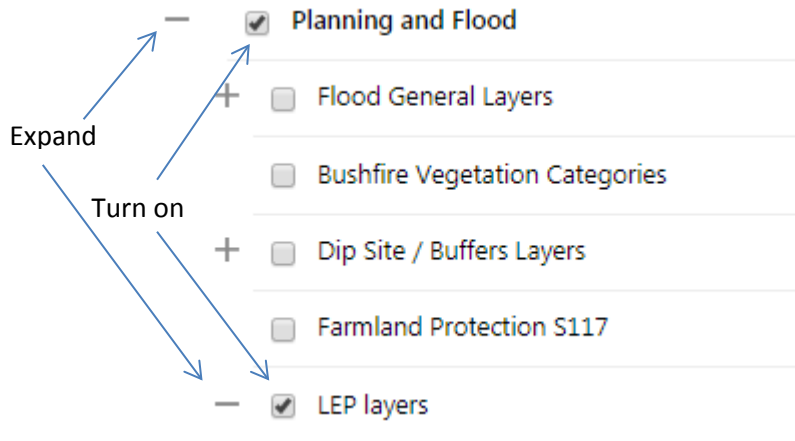
How to know what the layers are on the map

Use the Identify tool to click on the map. The layers that are *turned on* will be listed in the side panel.



How to find out which LEP zone applies to a property

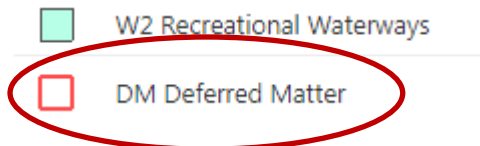
Turn on and expand 'Planning and Flood' layer. Turn on and expand 'LEP layers'.



Turn on the 'Land Zoning 2014' layer.



If your property zone is shown as DM Deferred Matter, then LEP 1988 applies.

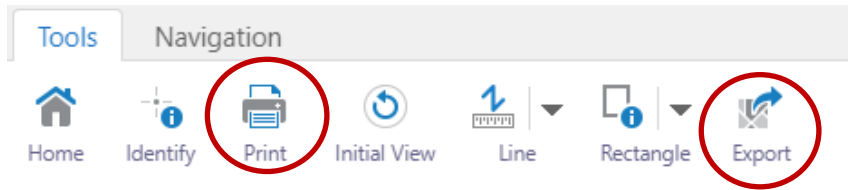


Turn on 'LEP combined 2014-1988' layer and use the Identify tool to find your 1988 zone.



How to print and export maps and data

You can print (to pdf) or export (image) a map.

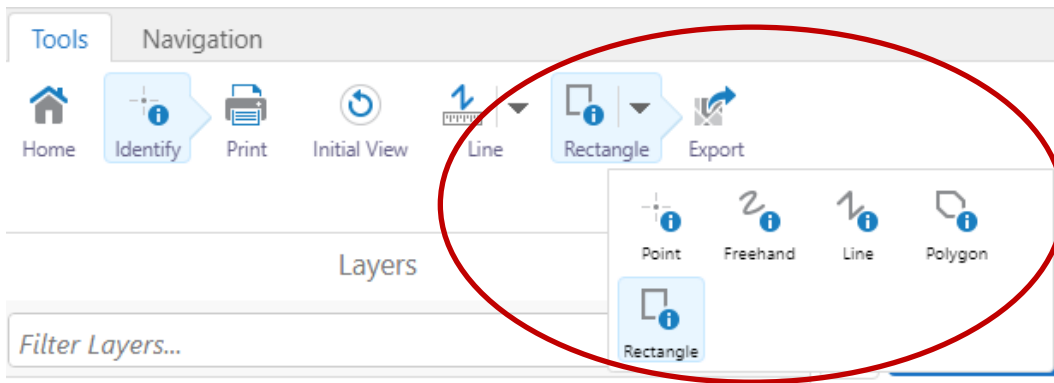

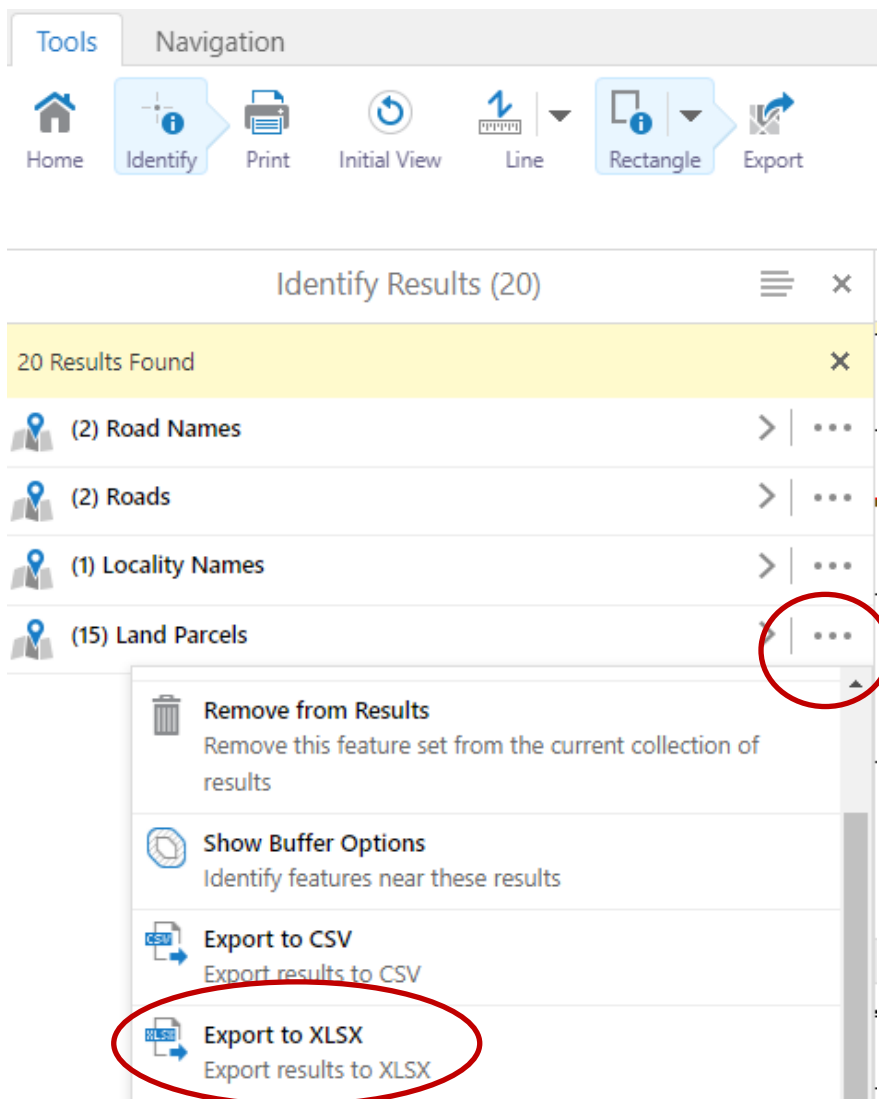
